## NO FILTER

- In recent years, the approach to some beer styles has changed. Whilst only bright beers were considered typical of styles in former times, opal coloured and unfiltered beers are now also found to belong to these.
- Many categories were thus opened to unfiltered beers, for example Vienna-Style Lager, New-Style Lager, Alt and all categories of Ales.
